

Initial Eligibility Assessment

In order to be initially considered for a new home or home repair as part of the Rebuild South Lafourche program:

The homeowner must have owned and lived in this owned home in the program service area on August 29, 2021, and this home was destroyed or damaged by Hurricane Ida.

If the answer to above is yes: Homeowner currently must have clear title to this residential property in the Rebuild South Lafourche service area on which a home could/may be built or repaired during the October 2023-May 2024 building season.

The Rebuild South Lafourche Service Area is defined as **South Lafourche south of the Intracoastal Waterway - Larose, Cut Off, Galliano and Golden Meadow.**

If the answer to both of these questions is yes, the client can then submit an application for program consideration. After the application is accepted, Rebuild South Lafourche volunteers may contact homeowners to obtain required documentation for clear title and other considerations. Back-up documentation listed on the application will need to be available and accessible. Submitting an application is only the first step and does not guarantee that applicant will be approved for assistance.
